Republican Views of the FBI and DOJ Have Moved Deeply Underwater While Democrats View Each Positively

Views of the FBI have soured among independents (net +10 favorable now, compared to +39 in April 2019) and Republicans (net -31, down from +6); views of the DOJ have improved among Democrats and independents, but have gotten worse among Republicans.








Majorities of Americans Are Hearing About the FBI Searching Mar-a-Lago and the Inflation Reduction Act's Passage








Nearly Nine in Ten Democrats and a Majority of Independents Believe Trump Committed a Crime as President

About the Study

Global Strategy Group conducted public opinion surveys among a sample of 1,000 registered voters from August 11-August 14, 2022. 106 additional interviews were conducted among Hispanic voters. 78 additional interviews were conducted among Asian American and Pacific Islander voters. 102 additional interviews were conducted among African American voters. 101 additional interviews were conducted among independent voters. The survey was conducted online, recruiting respondents from an opt-in online panel vendor. Respondents were verified against a voter file and special care was taken to ensure the demographic composition of our sample matched that of the national registered voter population across a variety of demographic variables.
