

What stood out most to you about Biden's speech tonight?


"When he was talking about Americans and how we have been taken advantage of for a very long time. That brought tears to my eyes because that was so true to me."

The Speech Made Participants More Optimistic About America's Future


Generally speaking, would you say the country is...?


Post-Speech Fewer Are Nervous Or Exhausted, And More Are Hopeful Or Optimistic

Which best describes how you feel about how things are going in the country?



Biden's Image Improves, Especially On The Economy




Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling the economy?

Most Movement On “Bringing People Together” & Being “Up For The Job Of President”


How well does each phrase describe Joe Biden?

Confidence Increased Most On Social Security/Medicare, Infrastructure, And Federal Spending


How confident are you in Joe Biden's ability to handle each of the following issues?

The Speech Made Participants More Hopeful Of Bipartisanship



Post-Speech More See Democrats As Focused On The Right Things


Do you think the Democratic Party is focused on the right or wrong things?




