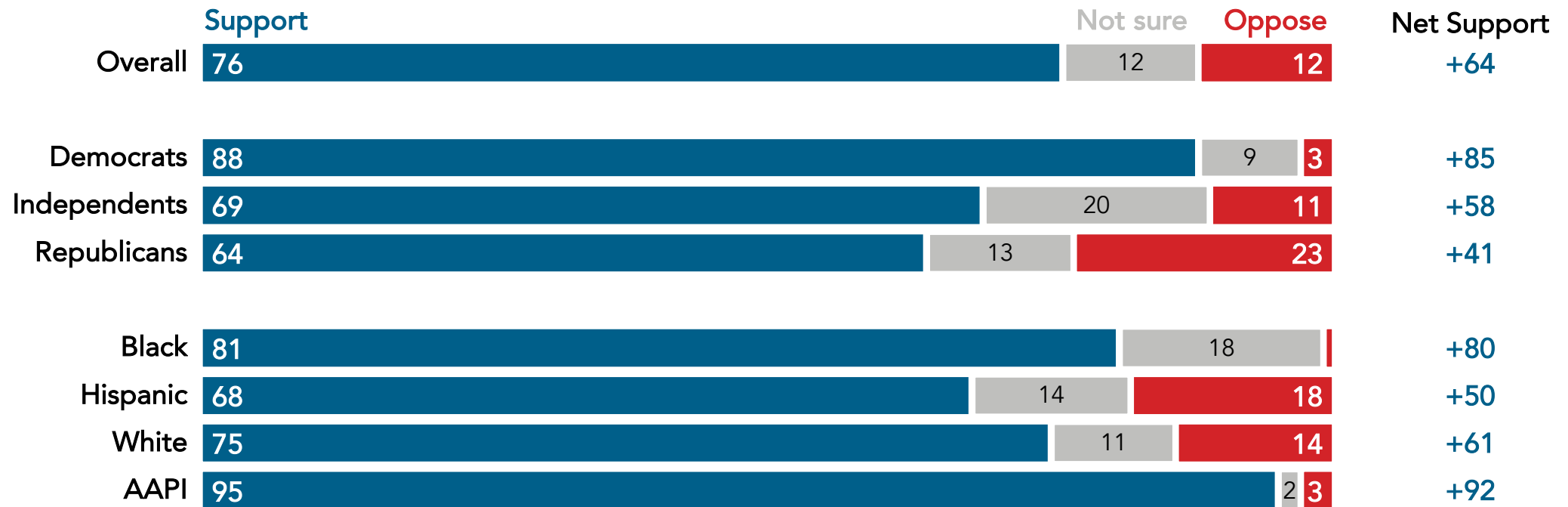


The IRS Providing Americans With the Choice to File Their Taxes Directly On its Website Is Deeply Popular Across Party Lines
