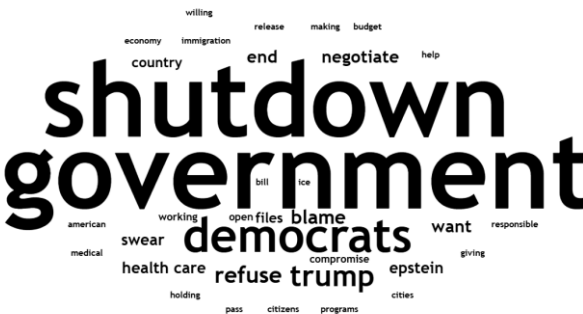

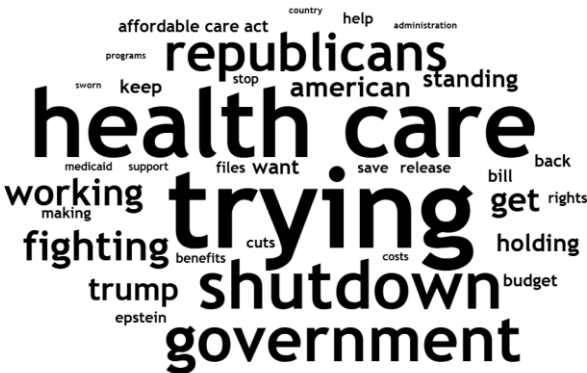

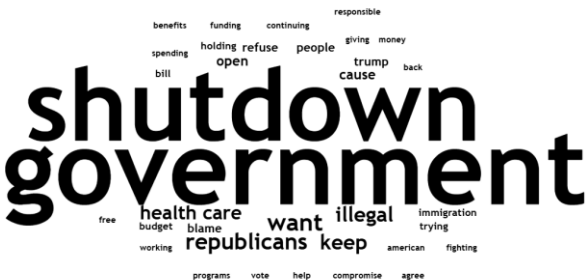

Q6. [IF A NEGATIVE IMPRESSION] And what, specifically, do you think **Republicans in Congress** are fighting for in this government shutdown?



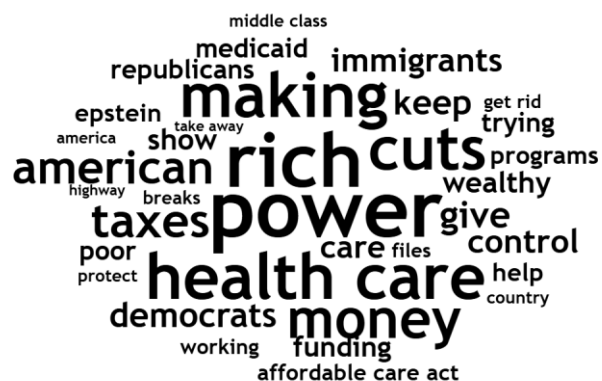

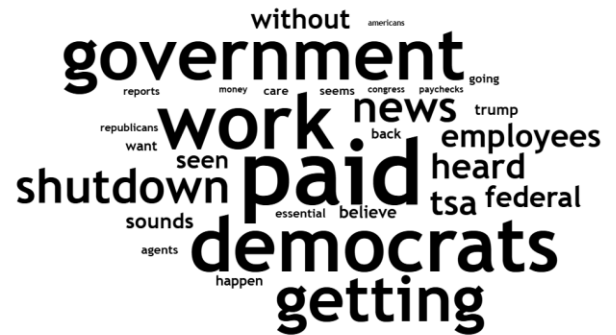
